Written by the nineteen ye composer in 1864-5, the piece won Fauré the first prize wh graduated from the École Niedermeyer and was first perfor the following year on August 4, 1866, with accompaniment strings and organ. It was first published around 1875 or 187 (Schoen, Paris, as part of the series Echo des Maîtrises) ar
